- 5:00, let's take Ray out for supper (optional, obviously, but all and sundry are invited). I'll reserve a table once numbers are confirmed, I guess at Bentley's. Beatrix will be along.

Rules

- The point is to learn how competitive play works, so the usual Laws of Chess apply.
- If you touch a piece, and it has a legal move, then you must move it.
- Clocks will be set to 30 minutes per player for the game. Digital clocks will be set to 25 minutes + 5 second increment (i.e., 5 seconds are added after every move).
- Both players must record the moves, unless they have less than 5 minutes remaining. Game scores will be collected by the TD and entered into a computer on-site, then returned.

System

- If you're not there at 1:00, then you will likely get a bye in the first round.
- Swiss pairings (in each round, players will face opponents with similar scores).
- The tournament will be submitted for "quick" rating by the Chess Federation of Canada.
- Players must be CFC members (\$44/year). Apparently it is no longer possible to pay a waiver fee. The CFC membership can be bought online or from the tournament director (Morgon).
